<b>1</b>	Participated in event/program sponsored by or behalf of an educational institution relating to careers in broadcasting	On September 29, 2025, our SEU welcomed a Western Kentucky University student, who was provided the unique opportunity of experiencing what it is like to work at a radio station and spent time observing our On-Air Personalities in action.
<b>2</b>	Training programs that enable station personnel to acquire skills to qualify them for higher level positions	From September thru December 2025 two of our On-Air Personalities have been working with one of our Program Directors learning how to schedule music, create/modify clocks and creating Phantom Producer liners. This training will provide them with skills that qualify them for a higher-level position in the future.
<b>3</b>	Sponsored event for or on behalf of a community organization related to careers in broadcasting	On January 16, 2026, our General Managers, Program Directors, Account Executives and On-Air Personalities gave a group of 36 students from the Hardin County Youth Leadership class ( <i>associated with the Hardin County Chamber of Commerce</i> ) a tour of our Stations, during which they talked about how radio stations operate and the opportunities available for a future career in broadcasting.
<b>4</b>	Participated in Job Fair	On February 24, 2026, this SEU participated in the Kentucky Career Center & Hardin County Chamber of Commerce Job Fair in Elizabethtown, KY. Our SEU Owner occupied a booth and was available to speak with attendees about career opportunities in radio broadcasting and accept resumes/ applications for an Account Executive position.

5	Hosted an Open House	On March 18, 2026, this SEU organized and hosted an open house at its studios in Elizabethtown. This event was widely promoted via on-air announcements, station websites, Facebook pages, Hardin County Chamber of Commerce and a posting at Elizabethtown Community & Technical College.
